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Facts about Occupational Therapy in Social Care England

- Approximately 2,500 Occupational Therapists work in Social Care in England(SfC data) (2,200 WTE's); Vacancy rate 8.2%
- In London 246 FTE in post; vacancy rate 17,5% (HEE 2016)
- Occupational Therapists work in adult & children social care organisations
- In Adult Social Care; Occupational Therapists deal with 40% referrals but over 2% workforce (DH 2008)

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- Occupational Therapists are recognised as competent to carry out Care Act assessments
- Social workers and Occupational Therapists both regulated by HCPC and have to meet CPD requirements for re-registration

Career Progression for Occupational Therapists

- Mixed responses  
- Anecdotally improved CPD & career opportunities appear to be linked to local senior manager occupational therapists appointment or where there is local support and understanding of the skills of Occupational Therapists
- Varied Pay Scales and nomenclatures

Principal Occupational Therapists

- Aware of three authorities with a Principal Occupational Therapists
- Many LAs tried to progress but many barriers put in the way

“There is no legal obligation to have a Principal Occupational Therapist but there is for a Social Worker”?

Senior Management



- Lots of positive feedback on opportunities for Occupational Therapists to apply for senior positions
- E.g. Occupational Therapists employed as safe guarding managers



- Many Senior OT Manager posts have been cut
- Occupational Therapists on lower salary scale to comparative posts for social work
- ‘Lead Occupational Therapy post’ tagged onto an existing job with no extra time allowed
- Resistance to move into senior role

Occupational Therapist Practitioner level



- Progression Frameworks for Occupational Therapists developed in some authorities
- LA Occupational Therapists on local leadership programme
- Rotations with health available
- Some competency progression programmes available for new graduate occupational therapists similar to new graduate social workers



- Lack of professional supervision for Occupational Therapists but recognised for Social Workers
- Funding for CPD mixed and linked to whether occupational therapy learning needs were recognised within learning & development posts in social care

Occupational Therapists working in Children service



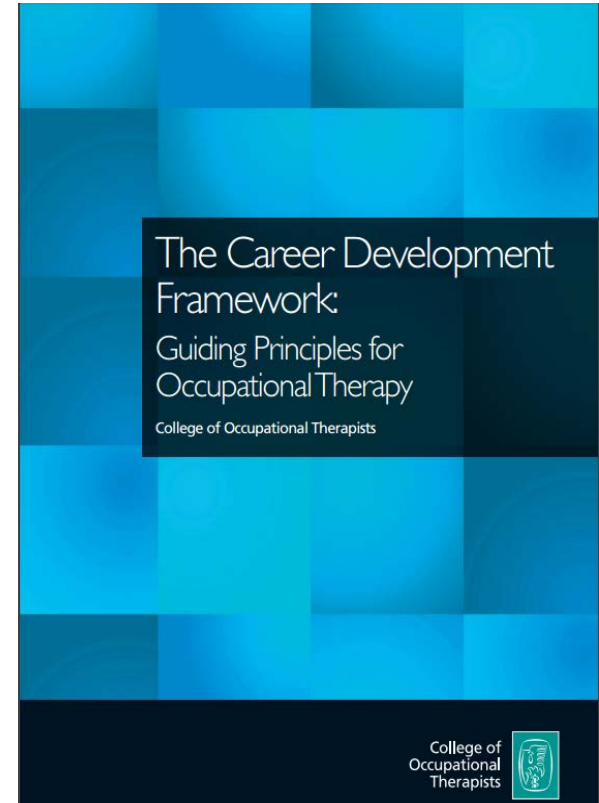
- Forgotten
- Skills not recognised
- E.g. Social Workers offered large financial retention package but not available for Occupational Therapists who were equally difficult to recruit
