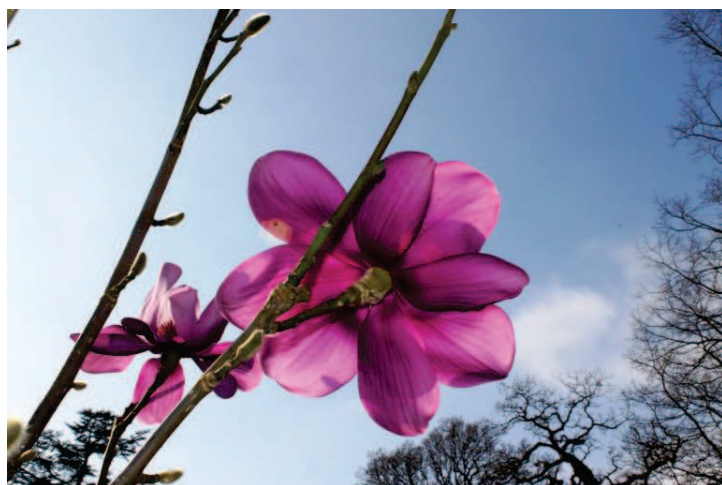

What is the Repository?

As part of the Learning Disabilities Mortality Review (LeDeR) Programme we have developed a national repository of anonymised case reports pertaining to people with learning disabilities.

The repository holds summaries of reviews including Safeguarding Adult Reviews, Serious Case Reviews, and Serious Incident Reports.

We thematically analyse these reviews to draw out common learning points and recommendations.
