Multi-Agency Adult Safeguarding policy and procedures refresh

- ▶ Consultation ran from 09 November 2018 to 21 January 2019
- ▶ 16 responses (161 pages of submitted amendments)
- ▶ Editorial group to meet on 22 February 2019 to finalise reviewing responses received.
- ▶ The policy and procedures will then be updated and sent to legal
- ▶ Final document will be presented to the London SAB on 24 April 2019
- ▶ Launch will take place shortly after 24 April 2019.

Safeguarding thresholds

- ▶ Aim:
 - To achieve a more consistent approach across London
- ▶ Objective:
 - To develop guidance / advice for professionals clearly articulating what good looks like
- ▶ Progress:
 - Ran a regional workshop Oct. 2018 to scope out the issues to feed into national conversation
- ▶ Next steps:
 - Identify the elements that would like addressed w
 - Share examples that would help work through the issues
 - Identify useful products e.g. advice documents etc.
